- Job Title:** Tutor Registrar in Psychiatry
- Reporting To:** Professor of Psychiatry and Senior Lecturer in Psychiatry
- Objective:** The principal objective of the post is to participate in the development, direction, teaching, facilitation and examining of the undergraduate teaching programme of students in Psychiatry

Specifically the duties of this post will include:

- Contributing to the development and delivery of the undergraduate teaching programme in Psychiatry
- Course facilitation and lecturing on the undergraduate teaching programme in Psychiatry
- Directing and co-ordinating specific programmes in Psychiatry in association with the Senior Lecturer in Psychiatry and the Professor of Psychiatry.
- Contributing to the clinical services of the relevant hospital as appropriate
- Ensuring that all Royal College of Surgeons in Ireland policies and procedures are adhered to.
- Complying with statutory legislation and Department rules and requirements in furtherance of your own and general staff welfare and safety
- Representing the best interests of the Department/RCSI at all times
- Performing such other duties as may be required from time to time.

Personal Specification:
